TOPIC	To the Rescue! This term our topic title is 'To the Rescue'. We are going to focus on one of the emergency services and think about how it helps us now and look at it's history. This week I'd like you to research 'emergency services' - particularly ones that we might need in Cornwall. Start by having a brainstorm - how many can you name? Ask your family too. Write them down on a piece of paper so you have a list Over the week I'd like you to build up a fact file of pictures, drawings and information. Just one page on each emergency service is enough.
