**Strengths**

**Areas for Development/ Improvement**

The LSCB has just updated its Threshold Guidance to include more information on children with additional needs and disabled children.

2.7.4 My advice in relation to FGM with primary aged children is to support them in being 'body aware' through PSHE.

In addition we need to:

- Provide a safe space for them to debate controversial issues.
- Help them to build resilience and the critical thinking they need to be able to challenge extremist arguments.
- Give them confidence to explore different perspectives , question, and challenge

This may be helpful. I have given this link out in the past and I understand from feedback from other schools through the S175/157 process that the lesson plans are suitable for use with primary aged children it is worth checking. PSHE –pshe-association.org.uk (FGM and CSE lesson plans).
