Dear Parents.

A very warm welcome back to school and I do hope you had a lovely half term. Assembly this week was led by one of our parents Mrs. Laskey who is part of the school Eco club. This term, our whole school Assembly theme is focusing on how we can look after the environment. In school we will be focusing on three areas - biodiversity, water and waste. Each week we will also be celebrating in Assemblies the children in school who have been seen to be Eco Warriors this could be collecting waste on the way to school or suggesting ideas. To launch our focus Mrs. Laskey shared with us her work she undertook to protect orangutans. She showed a video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TQQXstNh45g about the effect that using unsustainable palm oil has on orangutans. Palm oil is a type of edible vegetable oil that is derived from the palm fruit, grown on the African oil palm tree. Oil palms are originally from Western Africa, but can flourish wherever heat and rainfall are abundant. Today, palm oil is grown throughout Africa, Asia, North America, and South America, with 85% of all palm oil globally produced and exported from Indonesia and Malaysia; but most of the time not using sustainable measures. As palm oil is used by many large companies, we are encouraging the children to write to these companies or draw a picture to share their worries, so that they use sustainable methods. I have enclosed some examples here:

Dear Kelloggs,

I am very worried about you using unsustainable palm oil in your cereals. Deforestation in Indonesia is endangering orangutans and many other species, people are losing their homes and it is contributing to changing the world climate in very bad ways.

I like to eat cereal so please stop using dirty palm oil and help to save the rainforest and orangutans.
