

Staying at home and away from others (social distancing)

The single most important action we can all take, in fighting coronavirus, is to stay at home in order to protect the NHS and save lives.

As an Easter activity:



Look at this pattern.
What fraction of each is white?
What fraction of Stage 4 would be white?
What fraction of Stage 10 would be white?
What would Stage 0 look like?

This pattern is called Sierpinski's Triangle.
