Learning Powers - Following our series of aspirational assemblies last term, we are now launching a set of learning powers in classes and Assemblies each week. These powers are aimed at supporting the children in ensuring they are maximising their learning as best they can and are based around 4 R's - Resourceful/Reciprocal/Reflective/Resilient. The aim is over the next year, these powers will be as much a part of the Chacewater learning ethos as the golden rules. Each week we will be introducing one of these and they will be linked to a character with a story to introduce them. Next week, we will be introducing the "Resilient Tortoise" to the children. We will start with the story of the Tortoise and the Hare and then discuss the attributes of being resilient - absorption (wrapped up in your learning)/managing distractions (recognising and ignoring things that distract you)/noticing (understanding and seeing all that is around you to make use of /perseverance (sticking with it and not giving up.)
