We have received confirmation that this year schools will not be required to send in any assessments for children. This means that there will be no Year 6 SATS test, no official phonics test, no Year 4 multiplication check, no EYFS assessment and no Year 2 official assessments. As you are aware, at the end of each year we send out reports. This year we have decided to do it based on the two terms children were in school - we will be sharing these with you the week before half term! In the report we will comment on the progress children were making before we broke for the epidemic. Hopefully you will find these useful.

As mentioned a few weeks ago, Mrs. Law returns to work today. We are so looking forward to her being back. Mrs. Nesbitt will continue in her SENDCO role.
