Dear Parents,

I do hope you are all safe and well. As ever thank you for the tremendous efforts you are making to support your child whether at home or in school.

This week we have spent a lot of time trying to see if we can bring any other children back into school under the very restrictive government guidelines. With the help of the Parish council we looked into using the WI hall to provide additional space – this was then dashed when the government announced on Monday you couldn't; we looked into using marquees to provide additional space but unfortunately this is not practical. Very sadly it means that due to the fact all our staff (and additional) are being used in school and all the school space is being used for the year groups back we are unable to bring any additional year groups into school. As you can imagine I am very disappointed.

However, for the first time in many weeks it has now given us clarity to plan in advance a bit (as long as guidance does not change). Therefore, from week commencing the  $29^{th}$  June through to the end of term we will be holding daily "zoom" lessons for children in Years 2,3,4 and 5. These daily lessons will supplement the on line work. A full timetable will be sent out next Friday - there will be no clashes if you have more than 1 child. This is a new challenge for us as a school and the staff are working really hard to make it as effective as possible whilst still supporting the children in school at the same time.

Next week, we will still run the zoom lessons as planned:

Year 2: Monday at 130pm.

Year 5 : Thursday at 10am

Year 4: Thursday at 2pm

Year 3 : Friday at 10am

If you have not signed up to these sessions, please contact me and I will send you the links.


We still have no idea as to what September will look like but as soon as I do I promise I will let you know.
