









School Closure Plan – 6th and 7th December - Class: Mighty Oaks Year 6

<p>Monday 6th December</p> 	<p>Maths: Soon we will looking in more depth at fractions, decimals and percentages.</p> <p>Watch the video and lesson HERE to revise and recap on your understanding of equivalent fractions.</p> <p>Have a go splitting the cross below into quarters:</p>  <p>Can you find more than one way to do this?</p> <p>Challenge: Use your understanding of equivalent fractions to try find as many ways as possible of splitting the cross into 'quarters'.</p> <p>Tip: Look at each individual square of the cross. If you split each one of those into quarters you would have 20 equal sections in the cross. How many would you need to colour to show an equivalent to a quarter?</p>	<p>English:</p> <p>Descriptive writing linked to our theme.</p> <p>Watch the video HERE of a tour through a Viking village.</p> <p>Use this as inspiration to write a description of the village. Focus on the sense to help with this:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What can see? • What can hear? • What you smell? • What does it feel like? • What does it taste like (harder to fit in)? <p>Consider some use of simile and metaphors to help.</p>	<p>Wider Curriculum:</p> <p>In history we have been learning about the Vikings. Have a look at the lesson HERE and watch the video – What was life like in Viking Britain?</p> <p>Also check out the BBC Bitesize site HERE.</p> <p>In history one of the skills that we want to develop is to explore <i>similarities and differences</i>.</p> <p>Use your learning from the above links to show the similarities and differences between Viking life and our life today.
