Dear Parents,

As you will be aware, the Department for Education has informed all schools to close due to the Corona Virus outbreak. Our last day of being fully open is Friday 20^{th} March 2020.

As advised by the government we will do all we can to stay open for the children of key workers as a childcare facility who have been defined on the following link.

https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-maintaining-educational-provision/guidance-for-schools-colleges-and-local-authorities-on-maintaining-educational-provision. This provision will run through the Easter holidays.

All other children will need to stay at home, so please do not send your child into school from Monday 23rd March onwards. This is in line with government guidance about reducing the risk of spreading the corona virus by social distancing. As you can imagine, we do not know how long this will be for, but as soon as we hear anything we will of course let you know.

For our children in receipt of Free School Meals, I will be contacting you separately with some information.

We are incredibly sad that we need to close for most of our children but recognise our role in working together to do whatever is needed in these unprecedented times. I have outlined in this letter information about how we will be supporting your child's learning from home but I wanted to take this opportunity to highlight that whilst periods of isolation will undoubtedly be challenging, please know we are still available. We will do our very best to keep you informed as the situation develops and we get more guidance. Please keep checking the school website where we will post information as soon as it is available. If your email address or your phone number changes during this period please let school know as soon as possible.

Home learning - Over the past few weeks we have been preparing for closure and I can now release how we will support your child with home learning. Everything will come through the school website. www.chacewater.cornwall.sch.uk On the front page you will find a tab that says "Work While closed." On this tab, you will then find a link to every class in school. Please click on the tab to find information for your child's class. During term time, work will be set daily by 8am. For example, Monday 23rd March 2020. Everything that you need for the learning will be on that page. Teachers will also set up links where you can access supporting websites. We have also set up email addresses for all classes (below). Through these, you and your child will be able to communicate with your class teacher and also share work for the teachers to reply to. For KS 2 we have also got home access to Accelerated reader - we will put how this works on your class page. If you have any queries at all, please do contact your class teacher. As mentioned previously all Acorns work will be accessed through Tapestry including Daily phonics videos from Miss. Thomas.


