On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term in Seedlings.

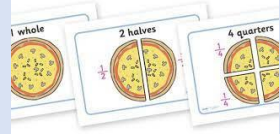
Maths

Fractions halves and quarters of shapes and amounts

Place Value to 100 counting to 100 forward and backward, partitioning (tens and ones), comparing, ordering, finding one more and one less.

Money recognising coins and notes, counting in coins

Time: dates, time to the hour, time to the half hour, writing time and comparing time.



English

Develop our spelling, grammar and composition skills through the stories of 'Stuck' and 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'.

We'll be practising writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. be applying our phonic knowledge to spell.

We'll also learn about contractions, plurals, adjectives, nouns, punctuation as well as using 'and' to extend sentences.

History: Significant individuals We'll be looking at Henry Trengrouse and Grace Darling and learning how their ideas and bravery contributed to modern sea safety.



Science: Seasonal Change Focusing on rain and shadows, we'll learn about the seasons and how they impact on our life.

Art & Design: 3D sculpture Using papier mache, we'll create a large lighthouse to link with our History lessons.

Design & Technology: Sliders & Levers We'll be recreating pages from the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.



Religious Education: How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter? Through religious and non-religious stories we'll learn about the benefits and responsibilities of friendship and the way people care for others.

PSHE: Growing and Changing What can I do now that I couldn't do when I was a baby? What will the 'future me' be like?

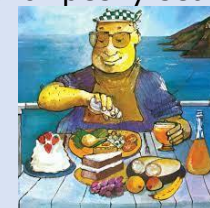
