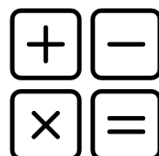
Theme: How did the Ancient Greeks influence our world today?

- division



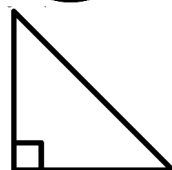
### Time :

- say family members age



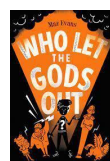
## P.E & Sport:

## English

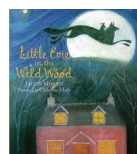
Reading: Who Let the God's Out by Max Evans
