Dear Parents and Carers,



What a week it has been at Chacewater School! It has been absolutely jam-packed with brilliant learning, memorable experiences and plenty of smiles, and we are all very ready for a well-deserved half-term break next week. We started the week on a real high on Monday when we had the privilege of welcoming Cat Burford, an inspirational adventurer who recently achieved something truly extraordinary. In January 2025, Cat

became only the 13th woman in history to ski 708 miles to the South Pole — solo and unsupported — fulfilling a childhood dream first sparked by her Geography teacher, Allyson Taylor. During the assembly, Cat shared the story of her expedition, from how she travelled to Antarctica to the specialist equipment she relied on, and the immense resilience required to complete such a demanding challenge. Her 50-day journey involved skiing uphill to nearly 3,000 metres in altitude while facing extreme weather and total isolation. Her message to all of us was powerful: pursue your ambitions with determination, embrace challenges, and never underestimate the impact that inspiration — or a teacher — can have. On Wednesday, Buds found a welcome gap in the weather and headed off on a brilliant geography field trip to Portreath Beach, bringing their learning to life in the best possible way. Around the school, there have been plenty of other highlights too. Bur Oaks enjoyed a fascinating science investigation exploring whether carbon dioxide weighs anything. They carefully weighed fizzy drinks, shook them up, released the gas (mostly carefully!) and weighed them again... all went smoothly except for one rather lively Sprite explosion — Mr Wilson sends his apologies! Red Oaks have been having a great afternoon in computing, creating carousels out of Pringle tubes and paper plates before using Crumble to write programs, test algorithms and bring their creations to life. And throughout the week, everyone has been thinking deeply about Children's Mental Health Week. Classes have taken part in a range of activities linked to belonging, reflection and wellbeing, including Buds and Seedlings making beautiful 'belonging cards' to celebrate the people and places that make them feel safe and connected.



Thank you to all our staff and pupils for another fantastic week of curiosity, resilience and joy. We hope you all have a wonderful half-term break — enjoy the rest, recharge, and we look forward to welcoming everyone back soon.

ParentPay – Booking Meals

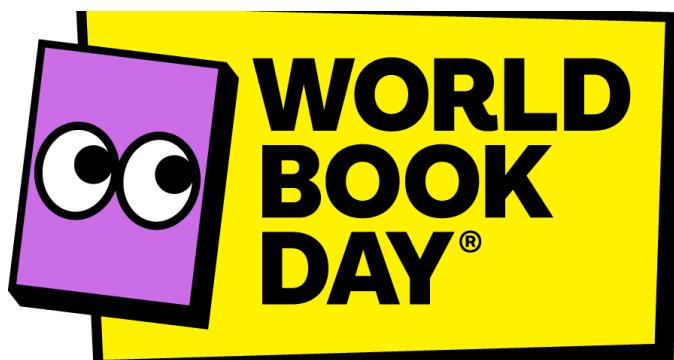
A little reminder to help our mornings run smoothly

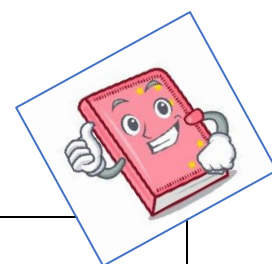
