## Household Support Fund


**Cornwall Council has received funding from the Government's Household Support Fund to help families with the increased cost of living. The money will support households in the most need against rising living costs, including energy, food and water bills.**

**Families with a child or children in Reception to Year 11 who is eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals can claim a cash payment of £80 per child by completing the application form at [Cost of living support payments - Cornwall Council](#).**

**Eligible families who apply will be sent full details of how to access their cash payment at the Post Office. We expect to start making payments before the start of the summer holidays. However, please note that this cash support scheme is not a direct replacement**

**for the previous Free School Meal Holiday Voucher Scheme and families may not receive their payment in time for the summer holidays. The Free School Meal Holiday Voucher scheme has now ended and no vouchers will be issued for the summer holidays.**
