Thank you, as always, for your continued support.

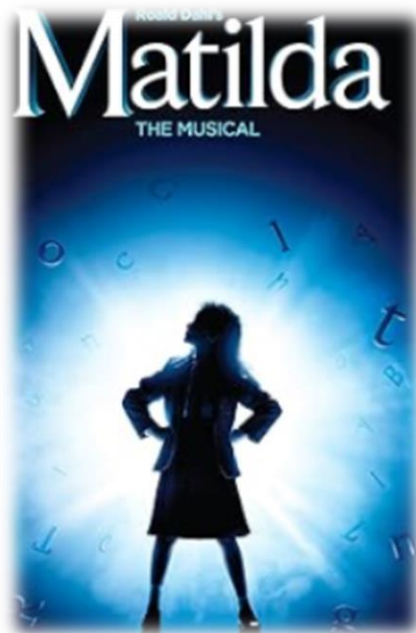

Richard Lander Induction Days – 30th June and 1st July

Transport

Richard Lander are providing transport for children from Chacewater to and from Richard Lander. We will be catching the coach from Kerley Hill at 8.55am and will walk the children down from school, therefore it is vital that they arrive at school on time. The children will return by coach from Richard Lander at approximately 2pm. Chacewater staff will accompany the children on the coach but will not be staying at Richard Lander.

Arrival

Year 6 students will be greeted in the bus lanes/car park by staff and directed into the building, where they will be welcomed by Year 8 helpers who will show them where to go.

Activities

Day 1: Fun activities in groups, aimed at getting to know each other and getting to know their way around the school building. Biometrics for cashless catering will also be taken (if consent was given on the admission form).

Each student will each be gifted a free copy of the book 'If the Invader Comes' by Tom Palmer, who is coming into school to speak to them.

Day 2: They will follow a timetable of 3 different lessons, to give them a sense of what a normal school day will be like.

What to bring each day:

Students should wear their usual primary school uniform.

- Packed lunch (*if your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please arrange for a packed lunch to be provided by their primary school for each day*).

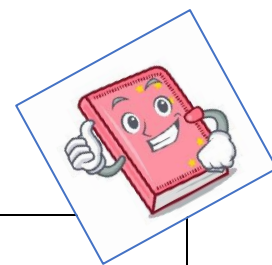
There will be 2 **FREE** challenges:
