Dear parents and carers,

The World Cup is now well underway and we started the week off with our own footballing success with another football match and a win for our school team, this time at home versus Mithian. In these matches it has been nice to be able to involve lots of people, while we find the right balance of including those who have more experience and those who have not played many matches. Over the rest of this term and next, I hope that we are able to arrange more matches and involve more children.

In assemblies this week we have continued to discuss the value of liberty in more detail, while looking closer at Qatar and the things that have been in the news recently about whether people think the World Cup should be held there. As always this promoted some really thoughtful discussion.

We have also looked at the government in this country and used this to introduce the plans for our own school parliament, which we will be setting up in the next couple of weeks. Some of the slides are below – ask your child/children how much they can remember!



Our plan is for each class to elect two representatives and these will change each term to allow for greater representation over the year. We will meet regularly to discuss school business and we hope enhance pupil voice across the school in lots of different areas. Children who would like to be a MCSP (Minister of Chacewater School Parliament) will need to prepare a few words which they will present to their class about why they would be a good MCSP. The class will then have an election to choose two.



On Tuesday the Mighty Oaks visited the Maritime Museum, linking to this half term's learning about the Vikings. Not only did they have a great time but it was also brilliant to hear what a credit they were to the school, with the staff of the museum commenting how it was a pleasure to work with them and how the children were

polite, respectful and demonstrated curiosity and enthusiasm. Well done Mighty Oaks!
