Year 2 Plans for Remote Learning Support

If your child is self-isolating because a family member is awaiting a test or showing symptoms please contact school.

Level 1: your child is self-isolating at home

Mrs Morgan will provide your child with a <u>Level 1</u> remote learning pack. It contains:

- Maths activity mats/5x table booklet
- Reading comprehension activities
- SPAG mat
- Common exception practise sheet
- Handwriting: letter formation

Work through these activities and bring the pack, with completed work, back into school when your child returns. The work can then be marked and feedback given.

Mrs Morgan will also make daily contact with your child at home by inviting them to 'zoom' in to the class story time from 10.45am-11am. Your child can then feel included in daily school life and see their friends remotely.

From day 2, a phonic lesson or task will also be sent daily through the eschools class page for your child to watch and complete this will be linked to the sound the children are learning that day.

Level 2: the whole bubble is sent home

- Plans for the day will be uploaded onto e-schools by 9am.
- At 9.30am a zoom session will take place. Your child will be expected to attend. The session will be around 20 minutes long and will include stories and phonic activities.
- Work will be sent on the e-schools platform. It will be a combination of daily recorded phonics lessons, Maths & English work as well as foundation subject activities like history, science, art etc.
- A Level 2 remote learning pack will be provided. It will include maths activities on the subject of 'time' and English activities based on the story of 'Bog Baby by Jeanne Willis'. The pack will complement the daily lessons.
