

Online Safety Newsletter

Instagram - Teen Safety Updates

Instagram has introduced new measures for users aged 13–17, including limiting content to what would typically appear in a PG-13 film. Risky stunts, strong language and potentially harmful content will be hidden or not recommended. A new **'Limited Content'** setting also allows parents to restrict comments and interactions further.

Online Gaming – What Parents Should Know

The newsletter outlines common risks such as chatting with strangers, inappropriate language, cyberbullying and in-app purchases. Families are encouraged to:

- Set up parental controls on both the game and the device
- Check age ratings before children play
- Talk regularly with children about safe behaviour online

Snapchat – Safety and Parental Controls


Snapchat remains popular with young people, but risks include inappropriate content, location sharing, cyberbullying and disappearing messages. Parents can use **Family Centre** to view who their child interacts with, restrict content and report concerns. Privacy settings should be reviewed to control who can contact or locate your child.

Family Smart Start – First Phone Support

A free toolkit is available to help families navigate giving a child their first phone. It includes setup guidance, safety conversations and a family agreement template.

Cyber Security - Protecting Your Family Online

The National Cyber Security Centre provides advice on staying safe from scams and cyber-attacks. Key tips include using strong passwords and enabling two-step verification. Guidance is also available on what to do if you are targeted by a scam.
