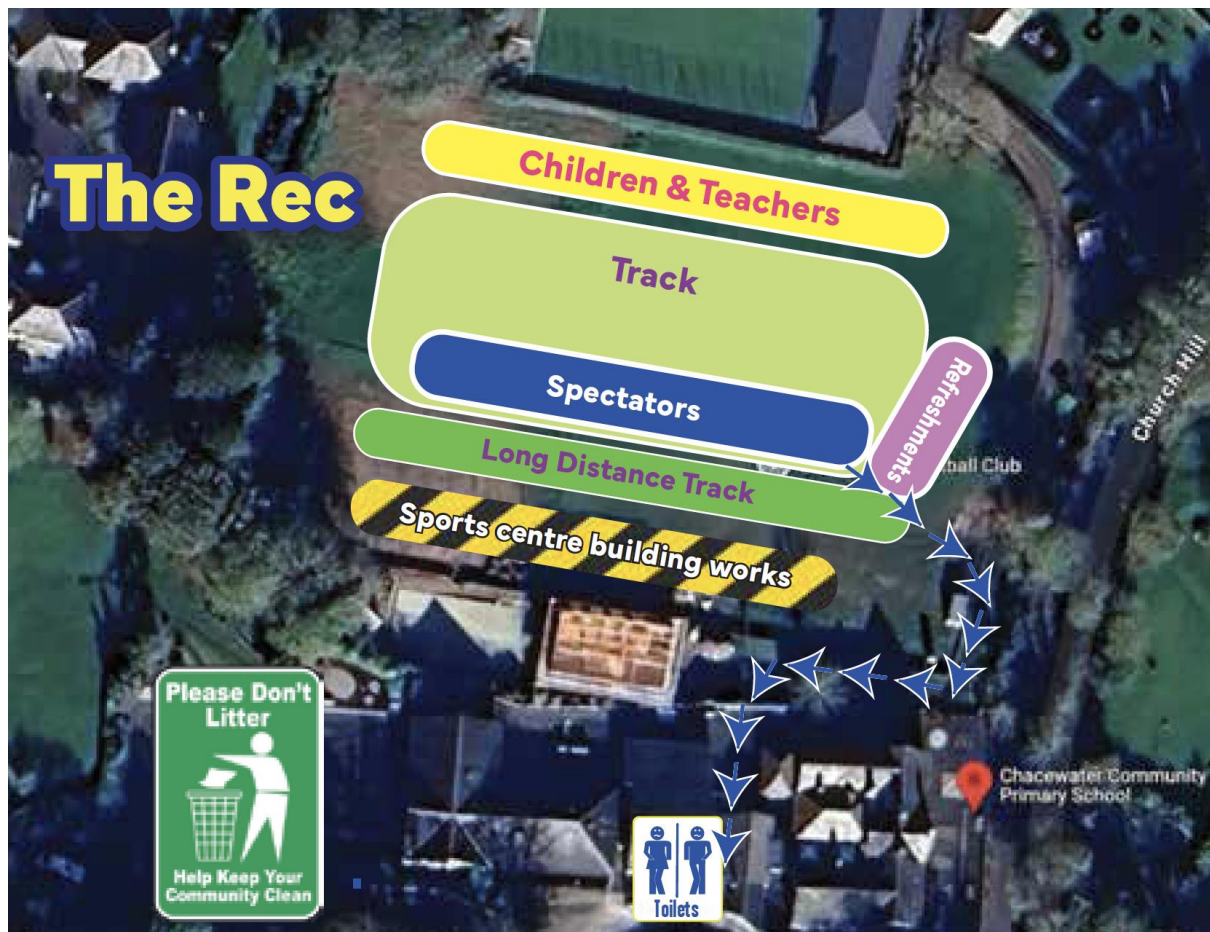

## Swimming – Mighty Oaks



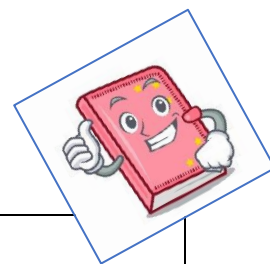
