Dear parents and carers,

This week we have mainly been thinking about change and how this can make us feel. We discussed in our assembly that 'moving on' can bring with it a vast range of different emotions - from feeling excited and happy through to feeling anxious and worried. Looking at different feelings and emotions, we established that they are all perfectly normal and that a change can actually help us grow.


Sports Day
