Fiction - Write a narrative based an episode of the original Paddington bear using dialogue

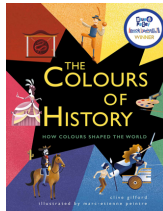
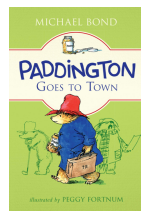
- Grammar & punctuation: Using the correct punctuation for direct speech, using adverbs including fronted adverbials.
