## Maths:

## Fractions

- recognise, find, name and write fractions $1 / 3,1 / 4,2 / 4$ and $3 / 4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity
- Children will learn simple fractions for example, $1 / 2$ of $6=3$ and recognise the equivalence of $2 / 4$ and $1 / 2$.

- Revision of all four operations: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication


## English:

## Fiction: Fatou, fetch the water

Writing outcome: write a story using pattern and a familiar setting.

- Use capital letters and full stops (Y1/2).
- Sequence sentences to form a short narrative.
- Use compound sentences (Y1).
- Expand nouns to describe (Y2).
- Use question marks and exclamation marks (Y2).


## Non-fiction: Big Cats

Writing outcome: write a non-chronological report

- Conjunctions
- Verbs
- Noun phrases
- Punctuating sentences


## Geography: Africa, Zambia

We will learn all about the location of Zambia in Africa and compare this to Cornwall. We will explore the village of Muguranmeno in Zambia and understand its human and physical features.

## Art \& Design: Printing

Children will be able to design their own block, create a repeated pattern and vary using different inks and coloured paper.

## Music: Linked with Computing

Children will perform and create simple three- and four-beat rhythms using a simple pictorial score.

Religious Education:
This term we will be learning all about Muslims and the religion of Islam.

This sequence of lessons will be exploring the importance of a healthy body and healthy mind.
