Pre heat oven to Gas 5/190C/180C fan. Cream together butter & sugar until light & fluffy, add eggs & sieved flour, mix well with fruit & sufficient water to give a dropping consistency. Put desert spoons of mixture into paper cases & bake 15-20 mins. This will make about 16
