## Spelling Shed

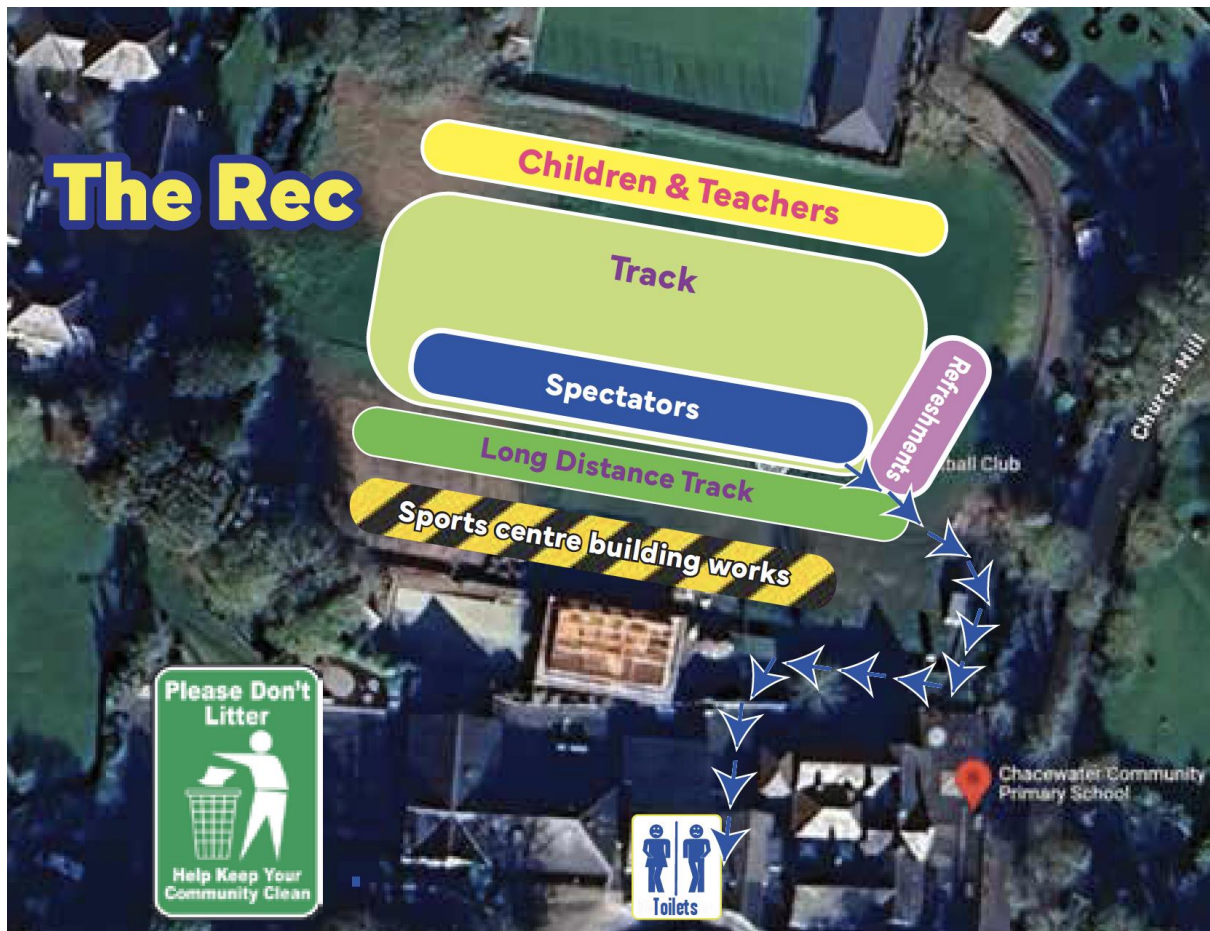

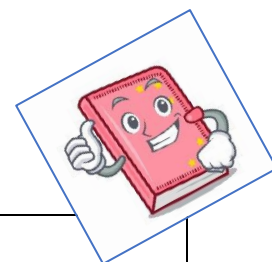
